Attention MTA Bus riders,

The Richfield Public School Academy board members approved the mandated Bus Pass Policy at the last board meeting. The New Bus Pass Policy states that; all students that are currently riding the bus MUST purchase a MTA Student bus pass for \$10.00 per family. All Bus passes must be purchased at the beginning of each month. If you need payment assistance, please contact Mrs. Clemons.

No more New Bus stops will be added on to current bus routes after October 1, 2013. Most of you are probably aware of the construction on Richfield road and Center road. This construction could cause bus delays so please don't assume that the bus missed your stop, it is probably running late due to the road construction.

MTA and Richfield PSA would like to ensure the safety of each individual child. Please make sure that your child is following the safety guidelines mandated by MTA safety regulations. If students do not follow these guidelines then they will be suspended from bus service.

- Students should not move to board a bus until it is completely stopped and the door is open
- Students should stay in their seats, when the bus is in motion
- Students should leave their seats only after the bus has come to a complete stop at a bus stop
- Bus rules prohibit eating food and drinking beverages while on the bus
- Students should not put any part of the body outside a window
- Loud talking, shouting or disorderly conduct is very distracting to the driver and should be avoided
- Students are not allowed to write on the seats or damage the bus in anyway. If a student vandalizes the bus, they will be responsible for the cost of the damages.
- All riders should help to keep the bus clean and sanitary on the inside
- Be courteous and obedient to your bus operator at all times
