Re: School Session Updates -**VIRTUAL UNTIL NOVEMBER 12TH**

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The health and safety of our students, staff and families continues to be of utmost importance to us. As you know, due to the reporting of positive cases and the movement throughout the district of our teachers, we decided that virtual school until November 9th was the best option to keep everyone safe. However, due the reporting of more positive cases, we will extend this format through November 12th with a return to in-person learning on November 15, 2021.

An issue that continues to happen is that students are not keeping their masks on while riding the bus and they are not staying in their seats. When this happens, we have students who are potentially exposing all of the other students on the bus. Please remind your children that riding the bus is a privilege and that it is required for them to wear a mask at all times and to stay in their seats at all times.

Masks are required of all students and staff when in school. Please remind your children that they must wear their mask, except during breakfast and lunch.

As a reminder: Please help us keep all of our students and staff healthy by using this guidance to determine when your child should be kept home from school due to illness:

**Fever:** If fever is 100 degrees or more child must stay home until fever free for 24 hours without support of medication.

**Vomiting:** Children cannot return to school for 24 hours after the last incident of vomiting.

**Respiratory Symptoms:** Cough, shortness of breath, runny nose, or sore throat WITH fever

**Cold Symptoms:** Children should stay home with severe symptoms, cough with mucus, vomiting, fever, thick mucus discharge from nose or fatigue, until these symptoms lesson and child is fever free.
